The Branson Veterans Memorial Garden was founded by Ben Kinel in 2007 honoring veterans in a public way with the living landscape of this garden. It runs solely on donations and takes a lot of money to run the garden. Representatives from the Veterans Memorial Garden have requested help from the City to assist in the upkeep of the garden.

This Ordinance approves the Public Service Agreement between the City of Branson and the Veterans Memorial Garden, Inc. allowing the allocation of \$5,000 to be used in 2024 for watering the garden.
