

RESOLUTION 2024-06

**HISTORIC DOWNTOWN BRANSON
COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT**

A RESOLUTION OF THE HISTORIC DOWNTOWN BRANSON COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT STATING ITS DESIRE TO BE RENEWED FOR 20 YEARS.

WHEREAS, the Historic Downtown Branson Community Improvement District (the “**District**”), established on April 29, 2006, by ordinance of the City of Branson, Missouri, is a political subdivision of the State of Missouri and is transacting business and exercising powers granted to it pursuant to the Community Improvement District Act, Sections 67.1401 through 67.1571 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri (“**RSMo**”), as amended (the “**CID Act**”);

WHEREAS, the term of the District is twenty (20) years, which means that the District will terminate in 2026;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 67.1481.6, RSMo, the City may adopt an ordinance to extend the District’s term after providing notice and holding a public hearing on the proposed extension, provided that the extended term shall not exceed twenty-seven years;

WHEREAS, the District desires for its term to be extended for twenty (20) years;

WHEREAS, the City has requested the District participate in a Board of Aldermen work session regarding a proposed District term extension.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE HISTORIC DOWNTOWN BRANSON COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

1. The District Board of Directors (the “**Board**”) finds that the free Trolley transportation within the District, promotion of District businesses, brochures, holiday lighting, landscaping, and other services within the District greatly enhance the District, its businesses and visitors, and should be continued.
2. The Board desires that the District’s term be extended for twenty (20) years.
3. The Board authorizes Vice-Chairman Junck to represent the District at a Board of Aldermen study session, and to provide appropriate City Staff with a copy of this Resolution.
4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its execution.
