AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE CONTRACTS WITH THE EMPIRE DISTRICT ELECTRIC COMPANY (D/B/A LIBERTY), SHO-ME TECHNOLOGIES, LLC, BRIGHTSPEED, AND WHITE RIVER VALLEY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE FOR RELOCATION COSTS OF UTILITIES RELATING TO WEST 76 COUNTRY BOULEVARD IMPROVEMENTS SEGMENTS 1 AND 2 PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Branson desires to contract with several utility companies for the relocation costs of utilities relating to the West 76 Country Boulevard Improvements Segments 1 and 2 project; and

WHEREAS, the contracts with The Empire District Electric Company (d/b/a Liberty), Sho-Me Technologies, LLC, Brightspeed, and White River Valley Electric Cooperative have been recommended for approval by staff; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen desires to approve the contracts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BRANSON, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Board of Aldermen hereby approves the contracts for the relocation costs of utilities relating to West 76 Country Boulevard Improvements Segments 1 and 2 Project as specified in the related specifications and substantial conformity with the terms shown on the following:

Exhibit "1" – The Empire District Electric Company, d/b/a Liberty in the amount not to exceed \$1,365,771.08

Exhibit "2" – Sho-Me Technologies, LLC in the amount not to exceed \$131,000.00

Exhibit "3" – Brightspeed in the amount not to exceed \$327,798.49

Exhibit "4" – White River Valley Electric Cooperative in the amount not to exceed \$25,000.00

Exhibit "5" – White River Valley Electric Cooperative in the amount not to exceed \$1,132,100.00

All attached and incorporated by these references as set out here in full, together with such changes therein as shall be approved by the officers of the City executing same which are consistent with the provisions and intent of this legislation and necessary, desirable, convenient or proper in order to carry out the matters herein authorized. The Mayor, City Administrator, and other appropriate City officials are hereby authorized to execute the Agreement and such additional documents and take any and all actions necessary, desirable, convenient or prudent in order to carry out the intent of this legislation.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon and after its passage and approval.
