

Staff Comments for the 56th Plumb Nellie Days Arts, Crafts, & Music Festival

Utilities:

- Applicant must call the Missouri One Call system for utility locates at 1-800-DIG-RITE or 811 before staking any tents, signs or banners in the ground.

Fire:

- A separate permit application will need to be submitted through Citizen Serve for any tents installed for this event.

Health:

- ORGANIZER: A TCHD (Taney County Health Department) Temporary Event Organizer Application is required to be submitted to TCHD at least 30 days prior to the event. The application must list all food vendors. Late applications will not be accepted. - A TCHD Temporary Food Vendor Application for each food vendor must be submitted at least 10 business days prior to the event. Each person selling, serving, sampling, or giving away food will be required to submit an application. Late applications will not be accepted. Public Works:

- City of Branson Public works will be providing all temporary traffic control devices for this event it will be the responsibility of the organizer to maintain these devices and make sure they are keep functional during the event. Water filled barricades will be used on N. Commercial street for additional pedestrian protection.
- Utilities for vendors need to be setup with he finance department prior to event starting
- No tent staking shall be driven into the concrete pavement. Stakes driven into asphalt must be fill upon removal with a cold mix asphalt mix and compacted.

Police:

- If temporary assistance is needed with the initial road closure for placements of barricades, contact the on-duty Police Sergeant. Overnight security, if desired, will be from a licensed security vendor or a local law enforcement agency. A separate security agreement will need to be completed. This is a Level 3 Event.
