

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ADOPTED 2022 BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF BRANSON TO ADJUST MONIES IN THE TOURISM FUND FOR THE GRETNA ROAD REPAIR

WHEREAS, Section 2-359 of the Branson Municipal Code states that emergency purchases necessitated by non-recurring emergency situations posing a substantial danger to the health, safety and welfare of citizens or of a risk of substantial financial loss to the city unless the required supplies, materials, equipment or services are obtained as expeditiously as possible and by written approval, the city administrator may authorize the purchase;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to use the fund balance in the Tourism Fund to transfer funds to the Capital Projects Fund in the Transportation Fund for the expenses related to the Gretna Road emergency repairs; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen desires to amend the 2022 budget for the Capital Projects and Tourism Funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BRANSON, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Board of Aldermen hereby approves the expense within the 2022 budget for the Tourism Fund as authorized below:
