

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ADOPTED 2023 BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF BRANSON TO ADJUST MONIES FOR ADDITIONAL EXPENSES IN THE PUBLIC SAFETY FUND AND APPROVING THE CONTRACT WITH NROUTE ENTERPRISES LLC FOR THE PURCHASE OF VEHICULAR REPEATERS AND ACCESSORIES AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT.

WHEREAS, Section 2-307 of the Branson Municipal Code states that any increase in appropriation within a budget fund shall require the approval of the Board of Aldermen;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to adjust monies in the Public Safety Fund; and

WHEREAS, the City of Branson desires to equip its police officers with effective emergency communications inside of buildings;

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen desires to amend the 2023 Budget for the Public Safety Fund and approve the amendment for the purchase and installation of repeaters

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BRANSON, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Board of Aldermen hereby approves the additional expense with the 2023 budget for the Public Safety Fund for the purchase of repeaters as authorized below:

Section 2: The Board of Aldermen hereby approves the contract with NRoute Enterprises LLC for the purchase of the vehicular repeaters and accessories as specified in the related specifications and substantial conformity with the terms shown on Exhibit “1” attached in the amount not to exceed \$170,506.02 and incorporated by this reference as set out here in full, together with such changes therein as shall be approved by the officers of the City executing same which are consistent with the provisions and intent of this legislation and necessary, desirable, convenient or proper in order to carry out the matters herein authorized. The Mayor, City Administrator, and other appropriate City officials are hereby authorized to execute the Agreement and such additional documents and take any and all actions necessary, desirable, convenient or prudent in order to carry out the intent of this legislation.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon and after its passage and approval.
