FACTS:

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is partnering with the Missouri Department of Conservation, to host a special archery hunt for youth hunters on October 14-15, 2023. The event will take place on Federal Land within the City limits at Table Rock Lake.

Sec. 58-97A (8) of the City's municipal code states that "The Board of Aldermen, by resolution, may authorize a special archery hunt on federal lands that are situated within city limits. Such resolution would authorize the federal agency responsible for management of the federal land, when acting in concert with the Missouri Department of Conservation, to host and select participants consistent with the following:

a. Provide facilitated hunts for the following hunters:

1. Youth hunters, under the age of 18.
2. Mobility impaired hunters, as determined by the Missouri Department of Conservation.
3. Military veteran hunters."

Staff recommends passing the resolution authorizing the special facilitated hunt on federally owned lands, which will be valid for a period of not more than 12 months from the date the resolution is passed.
